

CARBON POLICY STATEMENT



GPS is committed to minimizing the contribution it makes to climate change in manufacturing its products and providing services. It will do this by continuous improvements in production, reduction of waste and maximising recycling.

- GPS will identify, monitor and manage direct and indirect emissions of carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases. These include, those created by energy consumption at each stage of the print production process
- GPS will review its business travel and logistics arrangements to minimize the number of required journeys
- GPS will aim to minimise waste produced by our activities and maximize the amount of waste that can be recycled or reused
- GPS will purchase energy from renewable sources where practicable and economically viable
- GPS will work to achieve year on year reduction in carbon (or equivalent) emissions in relation to printed impressions

Managing our carbon emissions is a long-term commitment, and one that will only be realised through a staged approach using the best available techniques, technologies and information at the time.
